Ages 4-young 5 (turn 5 after June 1, some exceptions may apply)

- Enrollment:** 3,4, or 5 days per week
Register for 2-8 weeks, full or half days
Extended hours available
- Philosophy:** We want our campers to be active participants, learn new skills, have a sense of belonging, & security, & to acquire confidence & self-esteem
- Program:** These young campers are exposed to, and participate in, a wide variety of activities, geared specifically to their age & capabilities including: swimming, arts & crafts, music, dance, Audubon Arc, Native American, gymnastics, & beginning skill development in soccer, t ball, kickball, and basketball.
- Daily Red Cross: Instructional Swim**
The swimming area is very safe with a sandy bottom & designated for beginner & non swimmers.
Those who stay for full days have a second “fun” swim in the afternoon.
- Facilities:** The children have their own special facilities & play areas including a basketball court, soccer field, t ball area & playground. Their “home away from home” is a large spacious cabin with screened picture windows and individual cubbies for their belongings.
